Please print and fill out this form if you are interested in an assistantship for the Department of Interior Design. Prospective students applying to the program can scan and upload this document with the online application. Returning students should submit a hard copy to the Director of Graduate Studies in the Department of Interior Design.

All students on assistantship must take at least 9 hours of credit. Each student will be assigned to assist with a class or with a professor and will be expected to work 10 hours per week during the fall and spring semesters. Assistantships are assigned based on the skills of the students and the needs of the Department at the time. Typically, students on assistantship receive an in-state tuition waiver for 9-12 hours and also receive a stipend of approximately \$2,500 per semester. Students are responsible for paying their own fees. Students on assistantships are expected to progress in their coursework. Please realize that assistantships typically cover Fall and Spring semesters only. Students should plan to be financially responsible for summer terms, which are part of all of the master's degree programs. The maximum term for an assistantship is 1 year for Advanced Professional degree students and 2 years for MFA students. However, MFA students must reapply for the second year appointment. Assistantships cannot be extended beyond this maximum appointment. First Professional students are not granted assistantships during their first year of study.
