My research revolves around the temporal and spatial evolution of the domestic space, specifically areas related to the porosity of boundaries during COVID-19 and aspects affecting the physicality of space and the emotional well-being of its occupants. This exploration further examined work-from-home patterns, some related to design practice and organizational dynamics, and further changes in space typology around the domestic sphere. From this line of research, another similar but related track has emerged. This track encompasses creating architectural records of the ordinary within the built environment and memorializing them before substantial change occurs.
