WINDOW 1: Exam passed early February, before the end of Week 7 of the semester. To meet this deadline, submit final version of Chapters 1-3 to committee by January 15th.

WINDOW 2: Exam passed early April. To meet this deadline, submit final version of Chapters 1-3 to committee by March 15th.
